





In the identified area, the current year population is 34,764. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 34,291. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.61% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 36,219 representing a change of 0.82% annually from 2012 to 2017. Currently, the population is 50.4% male and 49.6% female.

Current median household income is \$60,481 in the area, compared to \$50,157 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$70,968 in five years, compared to \$56,895 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$70,483 in this area, compared to \$68,162 for all U.S households. Average household income is projected to be \$77,546 in five years, compared to \$77,137 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$24,656 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$26,409. The per capita income is projected to be \$27,322 in five years, compared to \$29,882 for all U.S. households

Currently, 75.5% of the 12,761 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 18.7%, renter occupied; and 5.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 11.4% are vacant. In 2010, there were 12,592 housing units in the area - 77.6% owner occupied, 16.7% renter occupied, and 5.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.59%. Median home value in the area is \$154,616, compared to a median home value of \$167,749 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.24% annually to \$172,747.
