Currently, 74.0% of the 61,593 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 22.4%, renter occupied; and 3.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 57,922 housing units in the area - 74.8% owner occupied, 20.9% renter occupied, and 4.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.77%. Median home value in the area is \$221,519, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.85% annually to \$242,795.
