The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 49.6 in the identified area, compared to 62.6 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$58,248 in the area, compared to \$52,076 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$70,943 in five years, compared to \$59,599 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$85,247 in this area, compared to \$72,809 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$100,564 in five years, compared to \$83,937 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$39,473 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$27,871. The per capita income is projected to be \$46,705 in five years, compared to \$32,168 for all U.S. households

Currently, 49.8% of the 150,735 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 42.4%, renter occupied; and 7.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 147,241 housing units in the area - 50.2% owner occupied, 42.2% renter occupied, and 7.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.05%. Median home value in the area is \$272,015, compared to a median home value of \$190,791 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.28% annually to \$319,611.
