The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 63.1 in the identified area, compared to 64.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 43.9% of the 223,078 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 48.5%, renter occupied; and 7.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 207,252 housing units in the area - 45.7% owner occupied, 46.3% renter occupied, and 8.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.32%. Median home value in the area is \$241,628, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.17% annually to \$269,011.
