Current per capita income is \$39,564 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$30,820. The per capita income is projected to be \$43,588 in five years, compared to \$34,828 for all U.S. households

Currently, 83.7% of the 45,851 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 13.9%, renter occupied; and 2.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 42,995 housing units in the area - 83.8% owner occupied, 12.8% renter occupied, and 3.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.90%. Median home value in the area is \$255,573, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.04% annually to \$282,733.
