Currently, 74.9% of the 75,019 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 21.6%, renter occupied; and 3.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 71,780 housing units in the area - 75.5% owner occupied, 20.2% renter occupied, and 4.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.98%. Median home value in the area is \$251,476, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.02% annually to \$277,970.
