Currently, 48.1% of the 193,668 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 44.5%, renter occupied; and 7.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 181,847 housing units in the area - 49.7% owner occupied, 42.5% renter occupied, and 7.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.84%. Median home value in the area is \$280,822, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.01% annually to \$310,228.
