The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 51.0 in the identified area, compared to 64.3 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 73.1% of the 60,822 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 23.0%, renter occupied; and 3.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 55,035 housing units in the area - 71.9% owner occupied, 23.0% renter occupied, and 5.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.54%. Median home value in the area is \$272,551, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.30% annually to \$305,336.
